## **Triumph Brewing Company wins ABC Award**

First the 100 plus year old shell was prepared to receive new fenestration, doors, an entry vestibule and an outside eating area. Interior fit-out involved specialized finishes including stained concrete, cork

flooring and mahogany and granite bar tops, sound soak custom millwork and specialized ornamental ironwork. The multiple level commercial kitchen was finished for cleanliness and durability with 3/8" thick high temperature polyurethane flooring and stainless steel wall panels. The building features a floating mezzanine and a heating and cooling system with 18 zones.





When we visited Triumph in December of 2003 Brian Fitting described their business as "first a restaurant, then a brewery." Brian went on to say, "the customer we are looking for is the discerning drinker and diner." Brian complemented Penn Valley Constructors on its overall performance, but singled out John DenBleyker, VP and Vilnis Ore, Assistant Project Manager for their ability to quickly research proposed additions and changes and the fairness of the financial consequences.
